SBA 2024 CURRICULUM

Villanova's Summer Business Academy will introduce students to the business landscape through a robust and interactive six credits of coursework delivered both synchronously and asynchronously. Students will gain an understanding of the dynamic nature of business, as well as opportunities for professional development. The program will culminate in a team-based capstone business-case project.

SBA students will benefit from innovative virtual instruction, applied and experiential learning components and professional development activities and events. SBA is a new program based on the proven methodology and structure of VSB and SBI courses, ensuring the same successful and holistic learning that students expect from a Villanova education.

SBA 1600 BUSINESS ESSENTIALS

4 credits

This course is an expanded version of VSB's 3-credit Business Dynamics course, which is a core requirement for all VSB and Academic Year Business Minor students. With an extra focus on interactive and applied learning, this course will for any application of extracurricular options available to them, such as the Gmelich Lab for Financial Markets and the Laboratory for the Advancement of Interdisciplinary Reserach (LAIR), along with their respective resources and workshops; the Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) training certificate; and a capstone business-case project.

SBA 1000 EXCEL ESSENTIALS

1 credit

This course will familiarize students with the uses and nuances of this essential program. It is similar to VSB's Information Technology course, a core requirement for all VSB and Academic Year Business Minor students.

SBA 1001

PROFESSIONAL SUCCESS ESSENTIALS

1 credit

This course includes instruction on professional development topics such as personal branding, resume review, and interviewing and networking skills. In addition to course instruction, this class provides experiential and applied learning components through virtual events, networking etiquette guidance and employer connections. This course is similar to SBI's Professional Success course, which is required for all SBI students.
