The committee met via Zoom on 2 different days and conducted the following business:

The commit ee spent most of the meet ngs discussing how to incorporate ULC into the faculty handbook. The following are the major points we feel should be in the handbook:

Make it crystal clear that videos of professors teaching their regularly assigned courses (not for hire) are property of the professor. The current language says that videos belong to the creator, and we wish to make it clear that the professor is the creator of the recording, not the University.

Limit to the minutes of the class.
Language about best pract ces
Opt-out will always be an opt on.
Who has access? What happens in a lawsuit?
How can students use the recordings?
Suggested syllabus language.

We were asked by the Faculty Congress CNT members to reconsider let ng CNT's vote for department chairs. The issue was discussed, and some more history of the vot ng rights debate was brought to light.

The idea of CNT faculty serving on the Dean Select on Commit ees was also introduced. The idea was tabled because we do not see why a CNT faculty member can help choose a dean when they cannot select their chairperson.

To Do:

Amanda will ask Alice Dailey where we can go with ULC and vot ng rights. The Ombuds reported to the FRRC chair and has some ideas for what the commit ee can do to address some of the concerns she has been brought in the past year. One init at ve being taken is to develop a training for department chairs. Another pressing issue is formalizing a way for successful tenure and promot on cases to review the
