Submission Components



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- g. Use numbers in parentheses for in-text citations, with "(1)" for the first in-text citation, "(2)" for the second, etc. Only assign sources a single number; if you use a source multiple times within the text, use the number that corresponds to the first me



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Submissions to VVRJ undergo several rounds of review before publication, including: (1) pre-review and plagiarism screening by the Editors-in-Chief, (2) full review by undergraduate researchers in the field, and (3) full review by faculty members in the field. Authors may be asked to revise their manuscript and resubmit for a second round of student researcher review (4). Authors and mentors will be notified of their submission status at each stage in the review process.
